By-law No. B2019-103

**A by-law to amend By-law B2015-072 being, ‘A by-law for
prescribing the time for setting fires in the Municipality of
Trent Lakes and the precautions to be observed’**

Whereas the Council of the Municipality of Trent Lakes adopted By-law B2015-072 being, ‘A by-law for prescribing the time for setting fires in the Municipality of Trent Lakes and the precautions to be observed’;

And Whereas Council amended By-law B2015-072 by By-law B2017-053 on May 16, 2019;

And Whereas the Council of the Municipality of Trent Lakes deems it desirable pursuant to Resolution Nos. R2019-029, R2019-534 and R2019-594 to further amend By-law No. B2015-072;

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Trent Lakes hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Title Section of By-law B2015-072 be replaced with the following:

This By-law shall be known and may be cited as the “Open-Air Burn and Fireworks By-law.” In the text of the By-law, it is referred to as “this By-law.”

2. That By-law B2015-072 be amended by adding the following subparagraphs:

- 1.7 ‘Display Fireworks’ means an outdoor, high-hazard firework that is designed for professional use only. They include items like aerial shells, cakes, Roman candles, waterfalls, lances and wheels. Display Fireworks are strictly regulated by Federal Law.

- 1.8 ‘Fireworks’ means Display Fireworks, Pyrotechnic special effect fireworks and Consumer Fireworks.

- 1.9 ‘Pyrotechnics’ are high-hazard and designed for professional use. They include items like gerbs, mines, comets and crossette fireworks, as well as special-purpose pyrotechnics made for live stage performances and the film and television industry. Pyrotechnics are strictly regulated by Federal Law.

- 1.10 ‘Weekend’ means the period from Friday evening through Sunday evening.

- 2.16 No person shall set off Fireworks within the Municipality of Trent Lakes at any time except as follows:

- a) **New Year’s Eve** – between 8:00 p.m. and 1:00 a.m. the following day;

- b) **Canada Day** – between 8:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on July 1st and the Weekends directly preceding and following it;

- c) **Civic Holiday** – between 8:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on the statutory holiday and the Weekend directly preceding it;

- d) **Labour Day** – between 8:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on the statutory holiday and the Weekend directly preceding it;

- 2.17 No person shall set off any fireworks in, on or onto any building, highway, sidewalk, Municipal park or Municipal property.

- 2.18 Property damage or injury as a result of the discharge of Fireworks

shall be the responsibility of the person and/or organization setting off the Fireworks.

3. This by-law comes into force and effect on the date of passage.

Read a first, second and third time and passed this 15th day of October, 2019.
